Position Profile

Fuller Theological Seminary invites candidates for a tenure-track faculty position as the Lloyd John Ogilvie Chair of Preaching beginning in Fall 2019.

Fuller is a multi-denominational seminary and seeks candidates who share its mission and commitment to training men and women for the various leadership roles in the church and the academy. The Lloyd John Ogilvie Chair of Preaching provides homiletical instruction and scholarship in preaching.

With a PhD (or equivalent degree) in preaching or one of its related fields, the holder of the Chair will be a full-time faculty member in the School of Theology.

General Requirements

1. Faith and lifestyle congruent with the mission of Fuller Theological Seminary as expressed in its [statements of faith and community standards](#). Fuller Seminary requires each faculty member to sign its Statement of Faith. Commitment to the evangelical and ecumenical heritage of Fuller Theological Seminary. 2. Commitment to theological education in the service of the local and global church, to shaping leaders for the church's mission and ministry, to the spiritual formation of students, and to supporting women and men in pastoral and other leadership positions.
3. Disposition to work collegially in a diverse—multi-ethnic, multi-denominational, multi-regional—seminary community.
4. Commitment to educating, affirming, and supporting women in all offices and ministries of the church.
5. Have the personal, academic, and/or professional development and experiences that enable effective service to the culturally, ethnically, racially, and theologically diverse student body of the seminary. Ability to teach in Spanish or Korean is an asset.

Teaching

1. Offer core and elective courses in the MA and MDiv programs, with the prospect of teaching DMin and PhD seminars highly desirable.
2. Proven record or demonstrable promise of teaching homiletics in a seminary context; Ability to teach in another area in the seminary curriculum (spiritual formation, evangelism, pastoral ministry, education, etc.) welcome.
3. Sensitivity to ecumenical and intercultural issues, to the contemporary world and its pressures and challenges, and to various theological and ecclesial paradigms, traditional and emerging.
4. A commitment to preaching as an integrative focus of theological education.

### Professional Qualifications

1. PhD (or equivalent) in homiletics or a cognate field.
2. Proven record or promise of publication, with ongoing research plans.
3. MDiv (or equivalent) and significant experience in congregational leadership.

### Rank and Other Considerations

1. Tenure-track; initial three-year appointment.
2. Rank dependent on qualifications and experience.
3. Date position available: July 1, 2019.

### Faculty Contract

1. Twelve-month contract, including paid four-week summer leave.
2. Teach fulltime: six courses per year on the quarter system, including at least two online courses/year.
3. Sabbatical quarter every seventh quarter.
